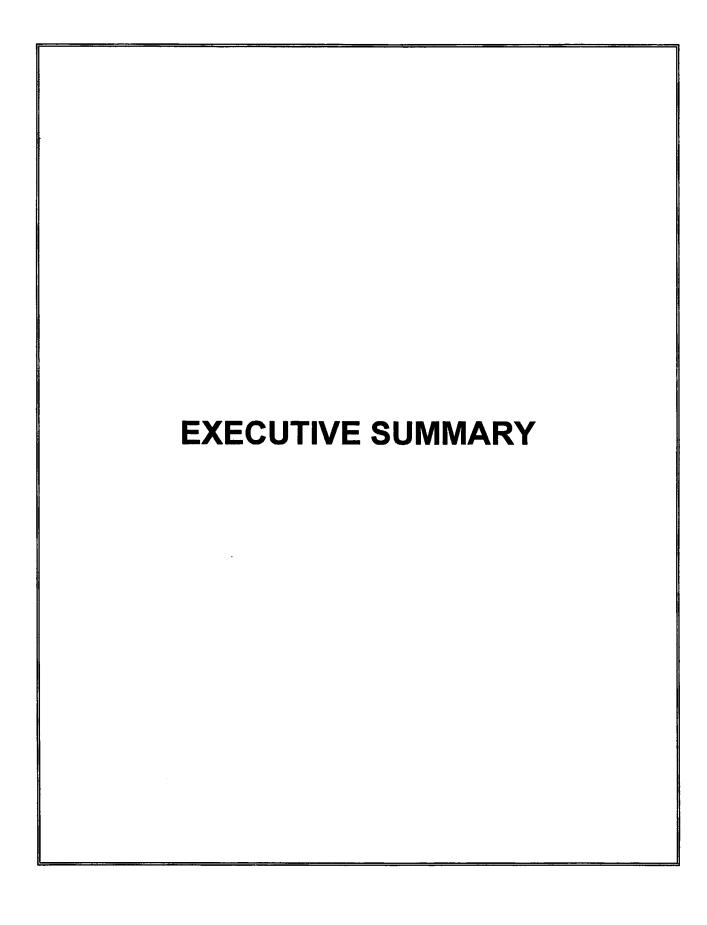

I recommend the Board of Trustees' approval of a \$2.88 billion fiscal year (FY) 2002 operating budget and authorization to the President to make necessary budget adjustments in accordance with the University's needs, the equitable interests involved, and within total income as it accrues. The Vice President for Academic Affairs and the Vice President for Administration prepared the budget based upon recommendations of: (1) the chancellors and provosts, after consultation with their respective deans, directors, and other campus officers; and (2) the President of the University. The allocation of funds follows general policies and priorities developed by these reviews. This \$2.88 billion operating budget represents a \$153.0 million (5.6 percent) increase from FY 2001.

University Revenue FY 2002

The source of funds for the FY 2002 operating budget includes estimated direct and indirect (i.e., payments on behalf of the University) revenue. Direct revenue includes appropriations by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois to the University, income fund revenue from academic operations (primarily tuition), grants and contracts for teaching, research, and public service, federal appropriations, private gifts including endowment income, institutional recoveries (overhead costs recovered from grants and contracts, private unrestricted gifts, and educational and administrative allowances), Medical Service Plan income, Auxiliary Enterprise operating income (i.e., Assembly Hall, Housing, Memorial Stadium, Parking, Pavilion, and Union operations), University Hospital and other departmental activity income (i.e., Intercollegiate Athletics, patient care at the Colleges of Dentistry, Medicine, Pharmacy, and Veterinary Medicine, etc.). "Payments on behalf of the University" are an estimate of State of Illinois appropriations to the Department of Central Management Services (CMS) and the State Universities Retirement System (SURS) who pay the State's cost for employee health, medical and life insurance and retirement respectively. It is important to note that this is the first time that "payments on behalf" have been included in the budget summary presented to the Board of Trustees.

The table below provides a comparative analysis of fiscal year 2001 and 2002 operating revenue and estimated revenue sources. Following this table is an analysis of the major changes in funding from FY 2001 to FY 2002 by revenue source.

State Appropriations and University Income Fund Revenue

State support from the Governor and General Assembly is increasing by \$48.8 million (6.5 percent). The primary use of these funds is for a general 3.0 percent salary program. Other major uses include recruitment and retention of critical faculty and staff; restoring faculty positions resulting from the early 1990's budget constraints; upgrading and improving student access to advanced technology; and advancing the University in the areas of computer science and biotechnology. Another significant component of the state funding increase is the Governor's Venture Tech initiative providing \$5.1 million to targeted areas of economic development and leading edge technologies. This initiative will help the University attract faculty and staff in high tech fields in plant, animal, and human health related genomic research, computing research and for the new Magnetic Resonance Imaging facility in Chicago. Lastly, the state is providing funding for unavoidable cost increases in Medicare, the operation for new facilities, library and utility price increases.

In addition to the \$48.8 million increase in direct appropriations, the University also benefits from appropriation increases to CMS and SURS for providing insurance and retirement benefits to University employees. We are estimating the increase benefiting University employees to be \$24.6 million (9.9 percent).

University Income Fund revenue is increasing by \$25.0 million (10.2 percent). A significant portion of the University Income Fund increase is the four-year tuition increase program. The first year of the program, a \$500 increase to incoming students, will generate almost \$9.5 million in program dollars for the campuses. We are earmarking the use of these funds for enhancements in student systems associated with the University of Illinois Integrate project, financial aid, and program improvements in the liberal arts

and sciences, commerce and other undergraduate programs. Standard increases and normal fluctuations account for the remaining increase in income fund revenue. The income fund estimates are net of approximately \$103.0 million statutory and institutional tuition waivers.

Even with the more robust State budgets of the last two years, the University found it necessary to reallocate approximately \$14.4 million in this budget cycle. This reallocation is necessary to meet the needs of high priority academic and support programs including salary competitiveness, recruiting and retaining new faculty, unavoidable costs such as legal liability costs, and other program requirements.

The following summary includes the General Revenue and Educational Assistance Funds appropriations budget by line item. The summary also includes special appropriations to the University.

Restricted and Institutional Funds Revenue

The budget includes an increase in restricted and institutional funds revenue of \$24.8 million (2.9 percent). Restricted and institutional revenues include grants and contracts, federal appropriations, private gifts including endowment income, Medical Service Plan, and indirect cost recoveries for these programs. This increase anticipates normal revenue growth.

The budget includes an increase in Auxiliary Enterprises and Administrative Allowance revenue of \$18.9 million (6.9 percent). Auxiliary Enterprise revenue includes Assembly Hall, Housing, Memorial Stadium, Parking, Pavilion, and Union operations. This increase reflects normal revenue growth and anticipates revenue growth due to the opening of new student housing in Chicago.

The budget includes an increase in Departmental Activity revenue of \$11.4 million (3.2 percent). Departmental Activities consist primarily of the University Hospital, patient care at the Colleges of Dentistry, Medicine, Pharmacy and Veterinary Medicine, Intercollegiate Athletics, and sales and services within the academic units. This increase anticipates normal revenue growth.

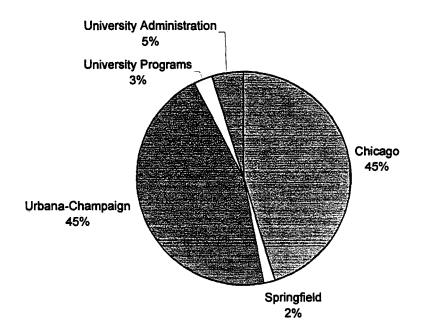

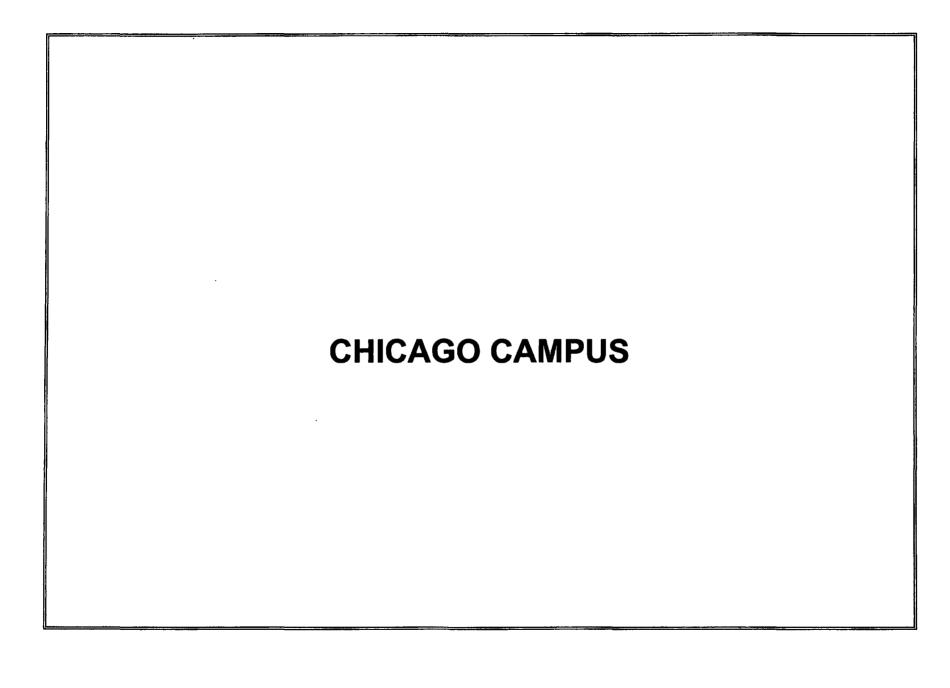

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

EXPENDITURE FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS

Academic Support

Expenditures to provide support services for the institution's primary missions--instruction, research, and public service. It includes libraries, museums, educational media services, academic computing support, academic administration, academic personnel development, and course and curriculum development.

Auxiliary Enterprises

Expenditures for self supporting operations which are not directly related to instruction, research, or public service units but which exist to furnish goods or services to students, faculty, and staff. Examples include food service, residence halls, bookstores, and student unions.

Hospital

Expenditures associated with the patient care operations of the hospital. It includes direct patient care, health care supportive services, and administration of the hospital.

Independent Operations

Expenditures of operations which are independent of, or unrelated to, but which may enhance the primary missions of the institution. It includes commercial operations such as Willard Airport at Urbana-Champaign and the steam plant in Chicago.

Institutional Support

Expenditures for central executive-level activities concerned with management and long-range planning of the entire institution; fiscal operations including the investment office; administrative data processing; space management; employee personnel and records; logistical activities that provide procurement, storerooms, safety, security, printing, and transportation services to the institution; support services to faculty and staff that are not operated as auxiliary enterprises; and activities concerned with community and alumni relations including development and fund raising.

Instruction

Expenditures for all activities that are part of an institution's instruction program. It includes credit and noncredit courses for academic, vocational and technical instruction, and remedial and tutorial instruction.

Operation and Maintenance of Plant

Expenditures of current operating funds for the operation and maintenance of physical plant. It includes physical plant administration, building maintenance, utilities, and custodial services.

Public Service

Expenditures for activities that are established primarily to provide noninstructional services beneficial to individuals and groups external to the institution. It includes such services as cooperative extension service, community service, and public broadcasting services.

Research

Expenditures for activities specifically organized to produce research outcomes whether commissioned by an agency external to the institution or separately budgeted by an organizational unit within the institution. It includes institutes and research centers and individual and project research.

Scholarships and Fellowships

Expenditures for scholarships and fellowships in the form of outright grants to students selected by the institution and financed from current funds, restricted or unrestricted including trainee stipends and awards. (Budget excludes the value of tuition and fee waivers granted staff and graduate assistants.)

Student Services

Expenditures for offices of admission and registrar and those activities which have the primary purpose of contributing to the student's emotional and physical well-being and to his or her intellectual, cultural, and social development outside the context of the formal instruction program. It includes student services administration, social and cultural development, counseling and career guidance, financial aid administration, and student admissions and records.

FUND GROUPS

State

Expenditures which have a source of funds of state appropriations or University Income Fund (primarily tuition).

Non-State Funds

Institutional

Expenditures which have a source of funds of institutional costs recovered from grants and contracts, private unrestricted gifts, and educational and administrative allowances.

Restricted

Expenditures which have a source of funds of U.S. Government, State of Illinois, and private grants and contracts as well as endowment income, private gifts, work study program, medical service plan, dental service plan, and federal appropriations.

Auxiliary/Departmental Activities

Auxiliary Enterprises

Expenditures for self supporting operations which are not directly related to instruction, research, or public service units but which furnish goods or services to students, faculty, and staff. Examples include food service, residence halls, bookstores, and student unions.

Departmental Activities

Expenditures for operations which are self supporting in whole or part that are directly related to the institution's primary missions -- instruction, research, and service.
